The Vermont Department of Health is standing up a Free Pop Up Covid Testing Clinic in Beecher Falls at the Beecher Falls Fire Station on Saturday, November 21, 2020 from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

## REGISTRATION

To help with Pop Up Testing Clinic Flow, the Vermont Department of Health is asking people to register for a testing appointment whenever possible.

To register, please go to <https://www.healthvermont.gov/covid-19/testing/where-get-tested> and click on **REGISTER FOR POP UP TESTING**.

**If you have participated in Vermont Department of Health Pop Up Testing, please click on LOGIN and enter your login and password information**

- You will then be asked to confirm consent and contact details.
- You will be asked if your scheduling an appointment for yourself and/or your dependents. Please click on the appropriate option(s).
- You will then be asked to click a location (a map will show up, please make sure that BEECHER FALLS is displayed and click on the BEECHER FALLS Clinic.
- You will then be asked to complete DEMOGRAPHIC information
- You will then be asked to complete TESTING QUESTIONS
- You will then be asked to complete INSURANCE QUESTIONS
  - PLEASE NOTE that it is not a requirement to have insurance.
  - If you have VERMONT BASED insurance, please include your insurance information (you will not be charged anything)
  - If you do not have insurance or if you have NH BASED insurance, please click NO
- You will then be asked to sign off on a waiver/consent form. Please click I AGREE. If you are scheduling a test for a minor dependent, please complete the information on the minor and click I AGREE.
- Next you will be asked to schedule an appointment and indicate if you have symptoms. You will be asked to select an appointment slot.

- If you are being tested for the first time at a Vermont Department Health Pop Up Testing, please complete the information under CREATE A NEW ACCOUNT
  - First Name
  - Last Name
  - Phone Number
  - Email
- You will then receive an email at the email address provided. Click on the link provided and confirm your login details:
  - Patient ID Number
  - Email address
  - Enter a password
  - Confirm password
- Once confirmed, you will then be directed to provide consent
- Next you will be asked to AGREE and to provide Attendee Personal Information
- Next you will be asked to schedule an appointment or add a dependent
  - Add a dependent first if you have minor children that you would like to schedule a testing appointment for
  - Then schedule an appointment
- Then Click LOCATION
- This will provide you with a map of testing locations
- Click on BEECHER FALLS FIRE DEPARTMENT
- Click on NEXT
- You will then be asked to complete DEMOGRAPHIC information
- You will then be asked to complete TESTING QUESTIONS
- You will then be asked to complete INSURANCE QUESTIONS
  - PLEASE NOTE that it is not a requirement to have insurance.
