INCIDENT REPORTING

Incident reports will be required when there are incidents that are outside of the normal requirements or conditions of a job or process. Use Incident Report Form to report the following:

- Workplace injuries.
 - All work related injuries need to be reported immediately to your supervisor.
- > Incidents related to the following:
 - o Office
 - o Highway Dept
 - o Police Dept
 - o Wastewater Collection and Treatment Plant
 - Water Systems Fire District I
 - Water Systems Fire District II
- > Types of Incidents to be Reported
 - O Damage to machinery or equipment resulting from an accident.
 - o Repairs to highway department vehicles, equipment, and buildings.
 - o Repairs to police department vehicle and equipment.
 - o Repairs to Transfer station and equipment.
 - o Repairs to Sewer Plant and Collection System.
 - o Report all tests that do not meet the Discharge Permit requirements.
 - o Repairs to Water Systems Fire District I.
 - o Repairs to Water Systems Fire District II.
 - Report all tests that do not meet the water quality standards.
