## MEETING MINUTES

**June 11, 2018**

1. Open Meeting – The June 11, 2018 Rec Park meeting opened at 5:10 p.m. Those present were Donald Labrecque, Dana Masson and Diana Rancourt.
2. Additions/Deletions to agenda - none
3. Motion was made, seconded and passed to approve minutes of the May 15, 2018 meeting.
4. Moose Festival – Vendor fee \$120 this year/Donation – Will pay vendor fee if we are able to get moose meat.
5. Use of Facilities Application – September 9<sup>th</sup> – info only.
6. Bleachers – Two sets of bleachers have been ordered and should be shipped out on June 13<sup>th</sup>. Dana will get a crew to put them together. Will order an in memory plaque when the bleachers are installed. Pictures will be taken and sent to the local newspapers.
7. Basketball tournament – Revenues and expenditures were discussed.
8. Dept of Building and General Services Grant – Diana will get prices for recognition plaques/posts to put around the walking path.
9. Movies in the Park – July 20<sup>th</sup> at dusk, movie, lights, food – A few movies will be picked and discussed at the next meeting. Lights will be put up on the gazebo and food and drinks will be sold by the Rec Park Committee members and Grace Community Church members.
10. Tennis and basketball court cracks – will discuss next year.
11. Volunteer day – the 9<sup>th</sup> grade students have volunteered to do work in the rec park to get a discount at the event they are going to. They will paint picnic tables and benches and put sealer on the dug outs and two of the shelters.
12. Sign for events – Diana will check with the Grace Community Church where they purchased their sign they use to post events.
13. Camping – Dana will take care of the camping again this year.
14. Shelter - \$300 ground work – Diana will check with TransCanada to see if the \$300 could be used for ground work for the soccer field since Richard Thibeault volunteered his time to do the ground work for the new shelter.
15. Bench – Adrien Thibeault ordered a bench from Hicks Hardware in memory of his wife.

16. Sign Warrant –Jeff will sign the warrant.
17. Other business: Cunningham’s was not able to pick up the roller from Roy Amey. Will try to figure out a way to roll later. The lights on the flag pole were replaced. Walking path will be discussed next year. Soccer and nerf style tournaments will be discussed at the next meeting. Donald ordered 24 yards of loam for the soccer field and Richard Thibeault will spread it out. Dana will try to find someone that has a liquid fertilizer. Repairing the soccer goals that are broken – Karen will discuss at the school board meeting.
