

Canaan Softball Park Camping Regulations

General Rules

- Cost per camp site \$100.00 for the weekend.
- One camper or three tents per site.
- Maximum of six persons per site
- Maximum of two vehicles per site space permitting. All other vehicles can be parked at the lot located near the entrance. This includes visitors.
- No dumping black or gray water on the ground. All campers are responsible for proper disposal of their black and gray water as allowed by law.
- Portable toilets will be available.
- No electricity available.

Trash

- Each site will be supplied with a Town of Canaan trash bag. You will be required to place all trash into this bag. Trash will be picked up by town. Trash pick-up will be available by 0900 on Saturday morning if needed. Trash pick-up on Sunday will be done after 3 p.m.
- Each site is responsible for keeping the site clean.
- **The town of Canaan recycles and it is required that you keep glass and aluminum in a separate container. This can be left on site and will be picked up by the town.**
- If extra bags are needed see site manager or check with person picking up trash.

Fires

- No unattended fires.
- Bonfires are not permitted.
- Only natural wood may be used in fires. No trash.
- Fires must be out by 12 a.m.

Pets

- Domestic pets are allowed.
- Pets must be kept on a leash as required by local law.
- All pet waste must be picked up and disposed of properly.
- Pets should not be left unattended.
- Any campers with aggressive pets will be asked to leave.

Noise

- All campsites must respect quiet hours between the hours of 11 p.m. and 7 a.m. Campers are responsible for any visitors on their site. Visitors should be gone by 11 p. m.
- Please be respectful of fellow campers at all times. Abusive or obscene language will not be tolerated.

The Town of Canaan reserves the right to request campers to leave if they fail to comply with any of these regulations without reimbursement. It is our goal to provide you with a safe enjoyable stay. Your compliance is greatly appreciated.
